Ascension of the Lord

June 1, 2014

We have two accounts of Jesus' Ascension into heaven. If the followers of Jesus wanted a phenomenon that related to super powers here it was! Jesus not just disappearing, but rising into the heavens in way that has captured religious art for all time. The apostles knew Jesus, they had eaten, slept and walked with him. They had shared conversations that were never written down. They had the complete Jesus experience that was going to make them demonstratively different for all time...but the separation from Jesus was to bring anxiety. In both accounts that we hear today the apostles show that. In the Acts of the Apostles account, the apostles are like children asking 'Are we there yet?' as they wait for the fine details of when and how the kingdom is to arrive. In the gospel of Matthew they fall on their feet before him. But both accounts end with messages of the hope of the continuation of Jesus mission that is so reassuring and hopeful for us today. "I am with you always, yes even to the end of time" St Augustine famously said that God is closer to us than we are to ourselves.

"Late have I loved, O beauty so ancient and so new. For behold you were within me and I was outside: I sought you outside...You were with me and I was not with you."


Walk with Christ Sunday 22nd June Feast of
