The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

November 9, 2014

It is always hard to explain to children that we are Church. Church is a building. For them it is like saying we are shops, or we are house and everyone knows that is silly!

In today's gospel Jesus introduced this confusing concept to the people of the Great Temple in

Jerusalem. For the Jews, this is where the Holy of Holies is, in the Sanctuary. It is here and only here that God lives. Jesus referred to himself as the sanctuary that was to be destroyed and to be raised in three days....and that is only after it took 46 years to build! Like much of what Jesus said the true meaning of this became so clear after his death and resurrection.

The early Christians really were Church as they had no place to meet that was safe. Where they gathered was Church. It was only after the Roman Emperor Constantine became Christian that the first Church of Rome, the Basilica of St John Lateran was built in 324AD and it is still today the cathedral for the Bishop of Rome, the Pope.

So today we celebrate that Church, our Church and us as Church gathered. Just as the presence of God in the sanctuary of the Jewish temple made it holy, so the presence of the Holy Spirit who lives in us makes us, the new 'temples', holy. We live within the new 'temple' constituted by the body of the Risen Lord, the sanctuary, destroyed and raised in three days.


