

## Gathering

*The entrance procession and its accompanying song, the greeting and penitential or sprinkling rite are all part of the opening or gathering rite of the Mass. Each element assists us to remember that we worship God not as individuals but as one. When the priest invites us to pray the opening prayer in Christ's name, we stand together as one body, the living Church of St. Vincents. Standing is the ancient Christian way of praying, and has traditionally been the way Christians reverence and praise God as a resurrected people. We sit to listen, to the Word of God and to the homily. The posture that our ritual requires at various times during the Mass, whether standing, sitting or kneeling is done in unison as a clear sign of our unity in Christ.*
